Their plan is to turn the more than 15-acre lot into a medical marijuana growing operation as well as a beer distribution facility for Rhinegeist. These opportunities could bring more than 100 jobs to Camp Washington.

People's Liberty Is Getting an Additional Home!

People's Liberty, a philanthropic lab that brings together civic-minded talent to address challenges and uncover opportunities to accelerate the positive transformation of Camp Washington, is setting up shop in Camp Washington.
