A Brief History of SpringDot

SpringDot (formally known as Sidney Printing Works) was founded by Sidney Deutsch, an 18 year old Hungarian immigrant in 1904. Sidney started by printing calling cards for those who came up to him on the street. He would set the type and print 100 first class cards. SpringDot is now being run by its fourth generation, Josh Deutsch, who joined the company in the late 1990s.
